D-14 MOBILE RADIO CONFIGURATION

Radio Configuration Mode when NOT on an active incident shall be:

- Heartland Zone 1 (Mode 1B-Zone) or Zone 2 (Mode 2B-Zone)
- SCAN ON
- Dispatch channel as

primary When assigned to an active incident:

- SCAN OFF
- Assigned command channel as primary
- Press "enroute" status
- Press "on scene" status
- Give size up to HCFA & responding units on command channel
- Switch to TAC when given an assignment by the IC
- Stay on Command when assigned to Staging, then switch to TAC once given an assignment.
- When completed with assignment, return to non-incident radio configuration mode, with **SCAN ON**

At no time shall any unit transmit over the dispatch channel.

When on an active incident, communications with dispatch will be on the assigned CMD Channel. Dispatch will monitor the TAC channel only if you request them to do so.

All radio traffic with HCFA outside of an active incident should be on Zone Channels (Modes 1B or 2B) IC and Command Staff may use command to communicate.
